I. Goal

The *Patient Consent* policy establishes the patient consent model for PeIEX.

II. Scope

This policy applies to PeIEX and data stored within PeIEX.

III. PURPOSE

This policy describes the responsibility of Partnership for Achieving Total Health (PATH), as the primary manager and fiduciary agent of PeIEX, to maintain the patient consent model for PeIEX.

IV. POLICY

1. All Participants are required to notify their patients of the PeIEX opt-out consent model. This notification provides each patient with instructions to manage their consent preferences.
2. Patient data may be shared among PeIEX participants involved in the patient's care, unless they opt-out.
3. The patient can elect not to have his/her medical records shared (opt-out) by completing the [Patient Opt-Out Request Form](#) or by calling PeIEX at (504) 301-9835.
4. Participants may assist the patient with the consent process through a variety of methods, including but not limited to, calling PeIEX on behalf of the patient or sending a secure communication.
5. Patients may choose to opt-in by calling PeIEX or by contacting us using the [Compliments, Comments, Concerns Form](#) on our website.
